We appreciate that a number of our children may have additional support needs and require further supports in relationships and behaviour. This policy does not detract from the additional support which some children with particular needs may require e.g. visuals, social stories, emotional literacy support etc.

In particular cases, individual targets, Additional Support Plans, Behaviour Additional Support Plans etc. will also be used as required, in line with SLC Promoting Positive Relationships and Understanding Distressed Behaviour Policy.

It is, however, expected that the vast majority of children will respond and benefit from the support and structures of the Relationship Policy which operates within Our Lady and St. Anne's Primary School.
