OUR VALUES AND VISION

During 2024/25 pupils, parents and staff revisited and refreshed our vision, values and aims. These set out the behaviours we value in OLSA as well as the hopes and aspirations we have for our whole school community.

We encourage our whole school community to demonstrate four key values, underpinned by Gospel values, which are:

Our high expectations for everyone underpin our aspirational vision. Our vision sets out what we want for our children, families and staff. It is captured in the phrase and acronym:

OUR AIMS

Our aims are based on our belief that *'the glory of God is the human person fully alive.'* We aspire for our children to develop the knowledge, skills, qualities and attributes that will allow them to flourish and achieve their full potential in life, learning and work. In OLSA, we believe that relationships and behaviour are as important as learning and achievement and we expect everyone to continually strive to create an environment that is safe, calm, welcoming, nurturing and inclusive.

PROMOTING POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS AND UNDERSTANDING DISTRESSED BEHAVIOUR

We recognise that social and emotional wellbeing goes hand-in-hand with relationships and behaviour. Through our Health and Wellbeing curriculum, we support children's social and emotional development. In P5 to P7 children engage in the Compassionate and Connected Classroom – a programme to help children develop strong, nurturing relationships and a sense of belonging.

OUR EXPECTATIONS

We recognise the need for **relentless routines** in OLSA and have identified the behaviours that will support us to achieve our vision and aims:

- ✓ **LEGENDARY LINES & WONDERFUL WALKING**: we move quietly and respectfully around the school.
- ✓ COOL SCHOOL UNIFORM: we wear our school uniform with pride because it gives us a sense of belonging.
- ✓ MINDFUL MANNERS: we say 'please, thank you, you're welcome.' We hold doors open for others.
- ✓ **RESPECT**: we respect ourselves, others and school property and treat *everyone* with the same respect.
- ✓ **RESPONSIBILITY**: we take responsibility for poor choices and mistakes by being honest and empathetic.


OUR VISION
