The amount raised was £500 and an appreciation of thanks was given to the Mini Vinnies who organised this year's fundraising events. As part of our Participatory Budget spending, a Multicultural day has been planned for Friday 2nd May. There will be stations throughout the school, planned by teachers. This will include food from various cultures as well as cultural dress and dances. The School Improvement Plan for the past year has included a focus on writing throughout the school. New interventions have been implemented and the children are responding well. The focus on writing will continue into next year's SIP. Views will be sought from parents on how we should spend the coming year's Participatory Budget. Pupil's views have already been gathered. We have been quoted £972 for repairs to our PE equipment and a further £360 to replace mats. At the moment we don't know where we have funds to cover this, as this could not be paid from PEF.
